Enrollment Goal

The PTO and School Board have established an enrollment goal of 180 students to start the 2014-15 school year. This is not a goal for those two groups but for the entire parish community; which needs to help our school grow. Financially the school needs the improved enrollment to increase income to support teacher salaries and extracurricular activities. These will all be explained in more detail at our Thursday January 16th Mandatory Parent Meeting.

Tuition Assistance and Scholarships

Any student wishing to receive some sort of financial help for the 2014-15 school year will be required to fill out a Catholic Education Foundation application. This application will be sent to CEF, but if you do not qualify under their criteria, we will evaluate for in house scholarship assistance. These applications will be available mid January and must be completed by March 28, 2014. This is a very strict deadline. All applications require proof of income: either 2012 Tax Returns or a notarized letter.
