CEF Applications

The CEF Applications for tuition assistance can be handed in at anytime before March 28, 2014. You must provide income verification usually by your 2012 tax return or by a letter stating your annual income that has been notarized. If you have your 2013 taxes completed and they have a lower income, that tax return will be accepted. If you have had some sort of financial setback this year that would reduce your income, please include a letter of explanation with your application. All new families that are thinking about enrolling for next fall need to fill out the application as they may receive tuition assistance for next school year. Even if you don't meet the qualifications of the Catholic Foundation we will be using those numbers for our in-house assistance. No family can receive assistance if they don't hand in a CEF Application.
