Enrollment and Registration

Enrollment for next year is our main concern as we intend to reach our goal of 180 students. This number is what we are basing our budget on for next year. Therefore, we ask each family to recruit as many new students as possible by letting them know all the good experiences your family has encountered by being here. In the past, we have had some families leave because of stability of administration, but we believe there is a future of stable administration not only at school, but also in the parish. Let's get our parish families back in our school and help the entire parish to grow.

We were searching for a way to streamline our enrollment and registration so parents can go online and complete these forms. We have found that our GradeLink site for your student's grades also has a component to facilitate this process. We will be using only the enrollment, as Mr. McMains would like to meet and talk with every family to discuss fees, tuition, and payment options. Enrollment will begin as soon as we contact GradeLink and have them customize our enrollment form, which is just an informational form with a variety of important details of your child. The advantage to using this GradeLink site is that most of the information we have on your student is already in this enrollment package and will be used for sequential years. This process will be completed through your student's GradeLink account so we will be resending usernames and passwords out by next week.

Registration, tuition, and payment options will begin after Easter Vacation, (April 28th) as we will be notified of families that have been accepted for CEF Tuition Assistance. Starting next week you can call Ana in the office to set up an appointment.
